FAIRSTAR APPOINTS NDRC DRILLING TO COMMENCE 10,000M DRILLING PROGRAM

Fairstar Resources Limited (Fairstar, the Company) (ASX: FAS) is pleased to announce that it has appointed NDRC Drilling Pty Ltd to conduct a drilling program of 6000 - 10,000 metres in the Company's Kurnalpi and Randalls Gold Projects.

The appointment of NDRC Drilling is a step towards Fairstar confirming current modelling concept and moving towards a JORC-compliant resource at these projects.

Reinterpretation and conceptual modelling of previous drilling has encouraged the Company to embark on its upcoming drill program.

Drilling will commence in early February and is scheduled for a six week period.

The Kurnalpi Project is located 95km north east of Kalgoorlie, in the Coolgardie Mineral Field in Western Australia. Historically, the Kurnalpi area has produced in excess of 18,650oz of gold from 14,292t at an average grade of 40.4g/t gold.

Fairstar Managing Director Kevin Robertson said he was delighted to have secured NDRC Drilling to conduct the next phase of drilling at the Company's highly prospective gold projects.

"The Kurnalpi area has a history of being a fertile gold precinct and we have been excited by the results we have achieved to date, and now look forward to progressing the next phase of our drilling programs with the objective of moving towards confirming a JORC-compliant resource," Mr Robertson said.
